SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Entry Fees: None

Eligibility:

- Keen interest in films from Southeast Asia
- Basic knowledge of film theory and critical writing
- Current student in a post-secondary educational institution
- Based in Singapore

Definition:

- Film theory aims to explore the essence of cinema and provide conceptual frameworks to understand film's relationship to reality, other artforms, spectators, and its significance to society at large.
- Writing sample relating to film refers to a reflective, research-based piece of writing where one formulates their own arguments, based on considerations of a variety of views associated with the topic.

Deadline:

- All entries must be submitted together with the completed submission form no later than **Monday, 21 August 2017, 6.00pm (GMT+8)**.
- Incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
- Any submissions received after the deadline will not be accepted.
