SUBMISSION GUIDELINES



INTRODUCTION

The Asian Producers Network is a platform for emerging producers from the region to deepen dialogue and discover opportunities for collaboration.

In its previous iteration, the programme provided participants with an environment for mutual learning and resource sharing. While this remains unchanged, the new iteration aims to significantly ramp up market exposure and industry engagement.

In a closed-door setting, participants can seek advice from industry experts through a series of guest lectures, individual consultation sessions and roundtable discussions. A range of pertinent topics will be addressed relating to project development, content production within the region, and support within the international film festival circuit and granting bodies.

ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITIONS

Applicant must be a producer of at least 2 short films that have travelled internationally and is currently producing a feature film which has the intention and potential for international co-production.

Applicant must be of Asian nationality, origin or residence.

Applicant must provide their project dossiers about the current feature film they are producing.

SGIFF will be able to provide accommodations and a flight stipend for participants.

The SGIFF Asian Producers Network will be held on-site in Singapore. Priority will be given to participants who can attend the programme in-person.

**APPLICATION
MATERIALS**

The SGIFF Asian Producers Network only accepts a secure online link of the portfolio work being submitted.

Films in any other language other than English must have English subtitles.

The project dossier should include:

- 1 Applicant's biography, photo and note of intention (Briefly state what you wish to accomplish at the Asian Producers Network)
- 2 Project information (logline, synopsis, director's bio, short director's note, financing plan, timetable)
- 3 Company profile and filmography, including upcoming films

Please submit all application materials in one PDF document and title the file '2024_Producers Network_APPLICANT'S NAME'.

DEADLINE

All entries must contain: a completed submission form, portfolio screener and project dossier. Submissions should reach us no later than Sunday, 31 August 2024, 6.00pm (GMT+8).

Incomplete submissions will not be accepted. Any submissions received after the deadline will not be accepted.

**SELECTED
PARTICIPANTS**

The SGIFF Asian Producers Network will notify successful applicants of the selection results by mid-October 2024.

The SGIFF Asian Producers Network does not produce individual explanation of the non-selection of an applicant.

Once an applicant is selected, the applicant will not be able to withdraw from SGIFF Asian Producers Network.

Workshops will be conducted in English; knowledge of English is essential in order to participate.
